

Uniform or Dress Code Requirements

Students will need to bring with them black pants (no leggings or jeans), black T-shirt, and all black shoes (should be tennis shoes, comfortable and supportive enough for a full day of working). Additional uniform items will be provided by department managers.

Students should be clean, presentable, and well groomed. No facial piercings or facial tattoos. Other tattoos are acceptable, however if tattoo contains content that could be reasonably considered offensive (i.e. nudity, profanity), it will need to be covered while in uniform. Hair must be natural colors and styles.

Housing costs are deducted from their paychecks.



House Rules

Specifics rules and regulations of Suncadia may change, but the currently rules and regulations are as follows: OCCUPANTS Only assigned team members may reside in the home. Other persons found to be residing in the home shall be considered a violation of this housing agreement and subject to discipline up to and including eviction from the property and termination of employment with Suncadia. A Roommate Change Request may be submitted to People Services if a team member would like to make a change but submitting the request does not guarantee a change will be approved. GUESTS & VISITORS Visitors and guests not listed on the unit's housing list are prohibited from staying the night or occupying the unit. Be conscientious and respectful of roommates in regards to inviting others over to the house and be sure to follow all rules and regulations (including quiet hours) if hosting guests. Team Member is responsible for the actions of their guests and any potential damages or infractions to housing policy while guests are on the premises. KEYS A Team Member living in housing will be given a key to their housing unit upon check-in. It is expected that the team member will keep track of their key. Losing the key will result in a \$100.00 fine. DO NOT give out or share the key with any other team member or individual. SMOKING & TABACCO PRODUCTS Smoking of any kind (including the use of e-cigarettes) is strictly prohibited inside any Suncadia Housing Unit and within 10 feet of any home entrance. Communal smoking devices, such as a hookah, are not permitted, even if unlit or intended to be decoration. Removal or tampering with the smoke detection device is strictly prohibited. Residents are responsible for testing this device at least once per month. If it is learned that you have been smoking inside the unit, a \$500 fine will be assessed. CANDLES & INCENSE The possession and burning of candles and/or incense is prohibited. Exception to this policy includes the burning of candles on a birthday cake or pie. CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR Individuals may not participate in any action or situation involving the physical or mental abuse, sexual or other forms of harassment, intimidation, hazing, pranks, or other conduct that recklessly or intentionally endangers or threatens the health, safety or welfare of any person or results in damage to the housing unit. This includes, but is not limited to, fighting and engaging in sports activities inside the housing. Behavior that is considered violent, including physical/verbal abuse and/or threats of harm or intentional damage to persons or property, will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Situations requiring immediate attention should be reported to the police by dialing 911. Non-urgent situations requiring attention can be reported to Suncadia People Services. An individual who is found to have broken this policy will be immediately terminated from their job at Suncadia and will be removed from housing. DRUGS & ALCOHOL All federal, state, and local laws regarding illegal drugs will be strictly enforced. No illegal drugs are allowed in Student/Team Member Housing. While Marijuana is legal in the state of Washington, it is illegal on the federal level and its use is prohibited within Suncadia Team Member Housing. The possession and consumption of alcohol by anyone under the age of 21 is illegal in the state of Washington. Contributing to minor consumption is an illegal activity and will be reported to appropriate law enforcement and will be considered violations of the Suncadia Drug and Alcohol Policy. Illegal activity will be reported to law enforcement and will be considered violations of the Suncadia Drug and Alcohol Policy, which will result in disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment and/or eviction from housing accommodations. DAMAGES TO PREMISES Team Member accepts responsibility for the home during the time of their agreement. Any damages that may occur to the premises must be reported immediately. Failure to report damages does not relinquish responsibility to said damages. Responsibility must be reported along with damages. Failure to take responsibility for damages will result in equal deduction from the Security Deposit from each Team Member residing in the home. Any unreported damages found after Team Member departures will result in equal deductions from eligible return of Security Deposit from each Team Member that resided in the home. ALTERATIONS Team Members shall not paint, wallpaper, alter or redecorate, change or install locks, install antenna's or other equipment, screws, fastening devices, large nails, or adhesive materials, place signs, displays, or other exhibits, on or in any portion of the premises without the written consent from Suncadia People Services. Any of the above noted acts will be considered damages and subject to the above listed terms. PETS Under no circumstances are pets are allowed in Team Member Housing. NOISE Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 7:00am daily. Please be respectful of roommates and neighbors and keep noise levels down. If the police are called due to a noise disturbance, perpetrators may receive additional disciplinary action from Suncadia. HOME RESPONSIBILITY & CLEANLINESS The entryway, bathroom(s), kitchen, living room, stairway, hallways, and hall closet(s) are considered common areas for those who live in the unit. The security and physical condition of these areas are the shared responsibilities of the Team Member and their assigned roommates. Please keep personal space clean and work with roommates to ensure the regular cleaning and tidying-up of common spaces. Suncadia will be conducting periodic housing inspections (see HOUSING INSPECTIONS) to ensure cleanliness. HOUSING MAINTENANCE Team Members shall deposit all garbage and waste in a clean and sanitary manner into the proper receptacles and shall cooperate in keeping the garbage area neat and clean. There should be no visible evidence of garbage outside of the homes designated garbage enclosures. Team Members shall be responsible for keeping the kitchen and bathroom drains free of things that may tend to cause clogging of the drains. Team Members shall be responsible for plumbing maintenance and fixtures that may need to be cleared of stoppage and for the expense or damage caused by stopping of water pipes or overflow from bathtubs, wash basins or sinks. Any maintenance issues must be reported immediately to People Services. Should damages occur due to a failure to report, said damages will be charged to all Team Members in the residence. GARBAGE & RECYCLING Please follow the instructions in your housing unit's welcome binder on how to properly dispose of garbage and/or recycling. SNOW Tenants are expected to maintain all snow removal on the property. Snow must be removed from the following areas: driveway, sidewalks, and decks/patios. Please update People Services if the home is in need of snow removal supplies (i.e. salt, shovels, etc.) FIREARMS/WEAPONS Possession, use, manufacture, transport, display, sale or distribution of firearms, fireworks, air-powered guns (e.g., BB guns, pellet guns, paint guns), knives, martial arts weapons and all other weapons or replicas of any of the above-mentioned items are strictly prohibited in Suncadia Student/Team Member Housing.

NAL PROPERTY Suncadia is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Team Members are rearrable for the security of their own personal items. Team Members may want to make

arrangements for insurance of their belongings. MISCELLEANOUS • Do NOT flush feminine hygiene products, baby wipes, condoms, or any items other than toilet paper down the toilets. • If you are unsure of how to properly use a household appliance (i.e. dishwasher, laundry machines), please ask Suncadia People Services before using. • Student/Team Member Housing may be located in a neighborhood that has a Homeowner's Association. Any additional Association rules & Regulations will be outlined in the home's welcome binder. It is expected that Team Members review these rules upon move-in and that they adhere to these rules during their time in Team Member housing. HOUSING INSPECTIONS Suncadia may enter, inspect and/or repair and maintain the premises at any time without notice. Weekly Inspections: Scheduled weekly inspections will be conducted by People Services staff to inspect adherence to all Team Member Housing Policies including cleanliness, damages and/or maintenance needs. Team Members must adhere to the Weekly Inspection Checklist in preparation. Failure to have home in desired condition will result in a written notice with a date of re-inspection. Failure to have action items corrected by time of re-inspection will result in deductions from security deposit. Detailed Cleaning Inspections: On a monthly basis Team Members will be required to thoroughly clean the entire home following the provided Detailed Clean Checklist. Detailed Cleaning Inspections will be completed by Suncadia People Services and/or Housekeeping Leadership. Failure to have home in desired condition will result in a written notice with a date of re-inspection. Failure to have action items corrected by time of re-inspection will result in deductions from security deposit. Random Inspections: Random inspections may occur as needed and are dependent on outcome of Weekly and Detailed Cleaning Inspections. Failure to have home in desired condition will result in a written notice with a date of re-inspection. Failure to have action items corrected by time of re-inspection will result in deductions from security deposit. CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES Please inform Suncadia People Services of confirmed check-out date at least two-weeks in advance. People Services will then coordinate final cleaning check and key return. Please Note: International Team Members on a J1 Work & Travel visa are allowed to stay in their housing for a maximum of 4-nights/5-days after their last day of work (i.e. their DS End Date). All J1 Team Members are expected to be checked out five days after their last day of work.
