Work Schedule Details

Schedules are made by direct supervisors and are posted in advance for employees to see and plan for. On average, students should expect between 32-40 hours per week with some weeks being fewer hours and some weeks being more. Anything over 40 hours in a week will be paid overtime.

Meals Included

Mandatory meal plan of three meals per day. There are no kitchens for cooking. All employees eat in the Employee Dining Rooms at their village.

The daily clinic fee is estimated at $\frac{1.14}{9}$ per day.

Paycheck Deductions (in addition to taxes)

The room & board fee is every 2 weeks and deducted from your paycheck, and is about <u>\$238.28</u> per paycheck. This includes all of your meals as well as your housing and associated housing fees.

There is also a required STGI Health Clinic fee of <u>\$1.14</u> per day day taken for support of the Medical Clinics inside the park. This is mandatory, per the National Park Service, for all seasonal concessions employees.

Dorms house 2 to 4 employees per room, depending on the size, with a community bathroom down the hall. Please expect to share a room with other Yellowstone employees, you may not get to room with your friends if there isn't a room available to accommodate you when you arrive. There is a manager on site with Residence Coordinators at each dormitory and security officers available.

Amenities include: laundry facilities, utilities, blankets, and sheets. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN TOWEL AND PILLOW.

House Rules

Quiet hours in all employee housing are from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., but there are some dorms which are fulltime quiet dorms. There is no smoking or vaping allowed inside, and must be done at designated smoking areas. If you're 21 years old or older, but your roommate is under 21, you cannot keep alcohol in your room. Tampering with or turning off smoke detectors will result in termination. There are monthly safety inspections for the dorm rooms, and all rooms will be inspected for safety violations. All employees must be respectful of other residents regardless of what time of day it is, and continued or excessive dorm issues can result in documentation up to and including termination from your job.

Cleaning Responsibilities

Yes, employees need to keep their dorm rooms cleaned, and excessive damage may result in maintenance fees. There are cleaning supplies in each dorm building.

Hospitality Crewmembers are responsible for laundry and housekeeping, kitchen and dining help, guest services, front desk, and groundskeeping/maintenance. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact InterExchange.

Additional Description

As a part of the Hospitality Crew, you will be placed in a kitchen OR housekeeping job. Your job assignment is decided on your start date in Yellowstone and is based on which department is in need of more employees at that time. Both positions are difficult and can be tiring; expect to be working and on your feet for most of your shifts.

Kitchen Crew:

- Dishwashing
- Preparing food
- Cleaning the kitchen
- Serving food in employee & guest cafeterias
- *If you're assigned a kitchen crew job, your manager will assign you a more specific role within the kitchen since there are so many different duties.

Housekeeping:

- Cleaning hotel rooms and guest areas
- Removing dirty towels, sheets, and pillowcases for laundry
- Replacing clean linens back into room
- Cleaning rugs and furniture with a vacuum cleaner
- Dusting furniture and equipment
- Emptying trash cans and cleaning them inside and out
- Cleaning floors with brooms/mops
- Using chemical-based products to clean tubs, sinks, countertops, mirrors, toilets, and shower curtains
- Replacing trash bags, soaps, bathroom items, and other supplies
- Transporting all trash to appropriate dumpsters or recycling areas

Both positions must be prepared to lift, push, or pull up to 75lbs, and be prepared to be working on their feet for 8+ hour shifts.
